
COMMENTS


A much higher quantity of 7.6 m/kgs was on offer this week which was an increase of 0.8 m/kgs over the previous sale. Low Grown Leafy teas totaled 1.9 m/kgs whilst Tippy/Small Leaf teas accounted for 1.1 m/kgs and High Grown teas on offer in the Ex-Estate catalogue amounted 1 m/kgs. The volume on offer at next week's auction is down to approximately 7 m/kgs but the following sale has a much larger weight of 7.8 m/kgs.

There was only fair demand for Low Growns. Better made leafy BOP1's / OP1's were about firm whilst the best available OP/OPA's too sold around last levels. Bolder Pekoes were irregularly lower albeit the best shotty PEK1's ruled firm. Buyers for the Middle East were active though more selective while shippers to Russia and the C. I. S. were more subdued. Iraq and Libya were active for secondary teas at lower market levels.

High Growns in the Ex Estate once again got a battering with prices easing a further Rs. 20/- to 30/- per kg from the previous sales levels. Plainer liquoring Westers with poorer leaf were heavily discounted following which there were many unsold teas as well. This trend is likely to continue throughout June when auction offerings will be boosted by rush crops. Buyers for Japan, Hong Kong, Germany and other European destinations confined their buying to the better made high growns whilst customary bulk buyers operated at the lower price end.

The Monthly and To-date National Elevational Averages that were released by the Sri Lanka Tea Board this morning appear elsewhere in this report. The following illustration for January / May, 2019 would signify the magnitude to which prices have fallen this year vis-à-vis the corresponding period in 2018.

- **BOP1**: A few select best invoices held firm; balance declined by Rs.20/- per kg. Teas at the lower end too were irregularly lower.
- **OP1** : Select best teas were lower by Rs.40-50/- per kg; balance too declined Rs.40-50/- per kg and at times more. Stalky invoices were fully firm at the commencement but declined Rs.20-30/- per kg as the sale progressed.
- Teas in the best category declined by Rs.20-30/- per kg; balance were lower by Rs.10-15/- per kg. Teas at the lower end too followed a similar trend.
- **OPA**: Select best invoices maintained; balance declined by Rs.10-20/- per kg and at times more. Poorer sorts too were lower by Rs.20/- per kg.
- **PEK/PEK1:** Well made shotty invoices were firm on last week levels; balance tended irregular. Best bolder PEK's were barely steady; balance was irregularly lower by Rs.10-20/- per kg. Teas at the lower end were generally lower.

CROP & WEATHER $For the period \ 27^{th} \ May - 02^{nd} \ June, \ 2019.$

Western Region - Mixed weather conditions with bright, overcast and occasional showers reported during the past week. Heavy showers are expected in the region according to the Department of Meteorology. Nuwara Eliya Region - Bright weather with strong blowing was experienced throughout the week in the region. Uva/Udapussellawa Regions - Dry weather was reported from both regions throughout the week. Fairly strong winds up to 40-50 kmph are expected in the hilly areas which is a sign of Uva quality season. Low Growns- Both Ruhuna and Sabaragamuwa regions experienced bright weather with several spells of scattered showers towards the latter part of the week. The Department of Meteorology predicts heavy falls above 100 mm in both regions in the week ahead.

Crop Intake - Western, Nuwara Eliya, Uva and Udapussellawa regions maintained the crop intake, whilst Sabaragamuwa and Ruhuna showed a decrease.

Demand: Fair demand. Larger brokens are selling at easier levels. Fannings ruled at lower levels with selective

demand from Internal and Upcountry buyers. Export buyers lent fair support.

LEAF-ORTHODOX:

Demand: Good demand.

Market: Market ruled at steady levels for the well-made whole leaf and bolder brokens.

Smaller brokens and plainers sorts less demand and eased in value.

Buying Pattern: CIS/Middle East exporters were fairly active. Upcountry buyers lent support on whole leaf grades.

DUST

Demand: Fair demand.
