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SALE NO.49 OF 09TH/10TH DECEMBER, 2019.

COMMENTS

There has been no letup in the heavy showers that have been reported from most plantations in the Uva and Central Provinces as well as Sabaragamuwa over the past week, whilst the latest news release from the Department of Meteorology indicates continued rains in the days ahead. Some upcountry estates have suffered landslides amidst the heavy precipitation which has negatively impacted the day-to-day work of estates.

This week's quantity of 5.2 m/kg showed a loss of approximate 0.4 m/kgs from last auction's figure. Low Grown Leafy/Tippy/Premium Flowery Grades comprised of 2.1 m/kgs, whilst Main Sale High & Medium category teas totaled 0.6 m/kgs. Teas on offer in the Ex Estate catalogue amounted to 900,653 kgs.

Low Growns catalogued in the 'Leafy' and Tippy/Small leaf' catalogues continued to meet with fairly widespread demand throughout the sale. Stylish BOP1's and OP1's in the "best" category ruled fully firm whilst a selection of cleaner teas in the "below best" category were dearer. Leafy OP/OPA's too were fully firm whilst shotty Pekoes were selectively dearer. The better FBOP's were irregular although others together with FBOPF1's were firm to dearer. Small leaf very tippy teas were keenly sought after, and, were fully firm to dearer. Buyers for Russia, Turkey and the C.I.S. together with Saudi Arabia were active for leafy teas. Iran was more selective, but there was sustained demand from the U.A.E. and other Middle Eastern destinations.

Ex-Estate teas met with fair general demand at irregular rates. A few top-end Westerns were maintained but others had overall lower quality. In the "below best" category, cleaner BOP/BOPF initially gained Rs.10/- and more, although this trend was not maintained throughout, which resulted in lower prices by the close of the sale. The high priced CTC High Grown PF1's of last week lost Rs. 30-50/- per kg whilst CTC Medium PF1's which commenced firm, closed Rs.20-30/- easier. Some of the top quality buyers from Europe and Japan were more selective. There was good interest from "bulk" buyers and those servicing "Tea Bag" orders.

- **BOP1** : A few teas in the select best category advanced Rs.30-40/- per kg; balance too were fully firm to dearer by Rs.10-20/- per kg. Teas at the lower end were maintained.
- **OP1** : Select best invoices appreciated by Rs.30-40/- and at times more; balance were dearer by Rs.20/- per kg. Stalky invoices too dearer.
- **OP** : Best teas maintained; balance tended irregular. Teas at the lower end held firm.
- **OPA** : Select best teas held firm; balance was dearer by Rs.10-20/- per kg. Poorer sorts too gained Rs.10-20/- per kg. Poorer sorts too gained Rs.10-15/- per kg.
- **PEK/PEK1:** Well-made shotty invoices declined by Rs.10-20/- per kg; balance tended irregular. Best bold Pekoe's were barely steady; balance declined Rs.10-20/- per kg. Teas at the lower end declined Rs.20-30/- per kg.

- **BOPF/BOPFSP** : Select best together with the best declined. Balance however firm on last.
- **FBOP/FBOP1** : Select best and best FBOP's were firm. Cleaner below best and cleaner teas at the lower end sold on last levels. Balance lower following quality. Select best and best FBOP1's firm. Balance were easier.
- **FBOPF/FBOPF1 :** Very tippy teas continue to attract good demand. Best together with cleaner below best and cleaner teas at the lower end appreciated. Balance were firm. Select best and best FF1's appreciated. Balance were firm on last.
- **FBOPFSP/EXSP :** Best tippy teas were firm to dearer whilst the others appreciated. Small tippy varieties met with good demand whilst below best were firm to dearer. Teas at the lower end too gained, particularly the cleaner varieties.

BOP: Best Westerns –select high priced teas of last week were irregular following quality whilst the others appreciated Rs.20-30/-per kg. In the below best category, brighter teas gained Rs.20/-per kg and more following special inquiry whilst the others were irregular. At the lower end, clean leaf teas gained Rs.30/-per kg and more whilst the others were barely steady. Nuwara Eliyas –brighter sorts declined Rs.20-30/-per kg whilst the others were firm. Udapussellawas were Rs.20-30/-per kg lower. Uvas continued to sell well, though irregular following quality.

BOPF: Best Westerns –select high priced teas were irregular following quality whilst the others were generally firm with select invoices gaining Rs.10-20/-per kg following special inquiry. In the below best category, brighter clean leaf teas were firm and tended dearer whilst the others tended easier. At the lower end, clean leaf teas were firm to marginally easier whilst the poorer sorts declined Rs.20-40/-per kg. Nuwara Eliyas were firm and Rs.30-40/-per kg dearer. Udapussellawas declined Rs.30-40/-per kg and more following quality. Uvas –select invoices were substantially dearer whilst the others were irregular.

Crop & Weather For the period 02nd -08th December, 2019

Western/ Nuwara Eliya Region : Clear mornings and heavy evening showers were reported throughout the week in both regions. The Department of Meteorology predicted fairly heavy showers in the afternoons during the week ahead.

Uva/Udapussellawa Regions : Both regions reported bright weather during the mornings and heavy showers in the evenings.

Low Growns : Bright mornings and scattered evening showers were experienced in both the Ruhuna and Sabaragamuwa regions. The Department of Meteorology expects showers (up to 50-75 mm) in the days to come.

Crop Intake Ruhuna and Sabaragamuwa regions showed an increase in the crop intake, whilst the Western, Nuwara Eliya and Udapussellawa regions maintained and Uva Region showed a decline.

BANGLADESH AUCTION

Sale 31 held on Tuesday 10th December, 2019

CTC LEAF: 68,680 packages of Current Season and 186 packages of Old Season teas on offer met with fair demand. **BROKENS:** A small weight of good Brokens on offer met with a good demand and were about steady. Medium varieties met with a fair demand but eased slightly whilst larger Brokens were irregular. Poor varieties were again a difficult market and withdrawals were heavy.

FANNINGS: Good liquoring varieties on offer were a good market and were firm to slightly dearer. Medium types witnessed a fair demand and were a little easier on last. Plain and poor types were again an easier market with heavy withdrawals..

CTC DUST: 9,695 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with an improved demand. The best liquoring teas met with a good competition and advanced by Tk.10/- to 15/- following quality. Good teas were fully firm to slightly dearer. Medium teas had fair demand. Brownish, plainer liquoring BLF teas were an easier market and witnessed fair withdrawals. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose teas buyers.

COMMENTS: It was evident throughout the sale that the market was closely following quality. Blenders lent good support for good liquoring varieties along with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers. Withdrawals continued to be heavy for plain and poor types particularly in the reprinted section of the catalogue.

CDs were a strong market.
