COMMENTS

The Western and Nuwara Eliya regions mainly reported dull weather with occasional showers throughout the week while Uva and Uda Pussellawa areas have enjoyed clear weather. Low Grown plantations have recorded bright mornings with sporadic evening showers. The Department of Meteorology predicts some more wet weather in the coming week across all planting districts. Meanwhile crop intake has remained similar to the previous week.

This week's auction (Sale # 39) was conducted on October 6 & 7 (Tue/Wed) and the quantity 5.4 m/kgs was spread over 10,112 lots and sold via Electronic Platform. The Low Grown Leafy/ Semi Leafy/ Tippy & Small Leaf/ Premium Flowery catalogues totaled 2.5 m/kgs, whilst Main Sale High & Medium category amounted to 0.6 m/kgs. The Ex Estate catalogue had 0.7 m/kgs.

Ex Estate teas again met with good demand. Best western BOP'/BOPF's were irregular while below best teas gained up to Rs.20/- and more. There was only a very limited availability of Nuwara Eliya and Uda Pussellawa BOP's/BOPF's which were much dearer following special interest. Uva BOP's advanced Rs.10/- to 20/- per kg. whilst their BOPF counterparts with neater leaf appreciated Rs.30/- to 50/- per kg. CTC PF1's saw better demand than in recent weeks which resulted in prices moving up for PF1 grades in particular. There was more widespread demand from China and the "Tea Bag" sector operating for Russia. Hong Kong and some Far Eastern markets too were active. Japan and Europe displayed good interest on the better liquoring teas.

Low grown leafy teas continued to meet with fair demand. Best OP1's were firm while below best teas were irregular and lower. Better made OP/OPA's maintained last levels but below best and secondary descriptions were Rs.10/- to 20/- dearer. Well twisted BOP1's in the "Semi Leafy" catalogue met with good demand and were fully firm to selectively dearer. Better made Pek/Pek 1's were barely firm on last levels but all others were firm to dearer. In the Tippy Catalogue, FBOP's in the "best" category were firm but select FBOPF1's ruled irregular. There was good interest from Germany for stylish BOP1's and selected OP1's along with Saudi Arabia for leafy teas. Other Middle Eastern buyers from Syria, Jordon and the U. A. E. together with Russia, the C.I.S and Turkey were active. Iran was more selective.

This week's auction comprised of **10,112** lots with a total quantity of **5,475,574** kgs.

LOW GROWNS - LEAFY

BOP1: Select best together with best category appreciated substantially; balance too irregularly dearer. Teas at the lower end were generally firm.

OP1 : Select best teas advanced Rs.40-50/- per kg; balance gained Rs.30-40/- and at times more. Stalky invoices tended irregular.

OP : Teas in the select best category appreciated by Rs.10-20/- per kg; balance was maintained. Teas at the lower end were firm on last week levels.

OPA: Select best invoices tended irregular; balance however advanced Rs.20/- per kg. Poorer sorts were barely steady.

PEK/PEK1: Well-made shotty invoices were generally lower; balance was fully firm to dearer by Rs.10-20/- per kg. Best bold pekoes were maintained; balance declined Rs.10-20/- and at times more. Teas at the lower end however gained Rs.20/- per kg.

BOPF/BOPFSP: In general were firm.

FBOP/FBOP1: Select Best FBOP's were firm on last levels. Best were firm to marginally easier. However, cleaner below best and cleaner teas at the lower end were maintained; others were irregular following quality. FBOP1's in general met with good demand.

FBOPF/FBOPF1 : Tippy teas were irregular and mostly lower. Best too were firm to marginally easier. However, cleaner Below Best and cleaner teas at the lower end appreciated; balance barely steady. The leafier varieties in general were easier. Select Best and Best FF1's held firm. Cleaner Below best teas at the lower end sold around last levels; others were easier following quality.

FBOPFSP/EXSP: Well made very tippy teas with a good show of tip met with good demand. Leafier types sold around last week levels. Best and below best declined. Cleaner teas at the lower end maintained; others eased.

BANGLADESH AUCTION

Sale 19 held on Monday, 05th October, 2020

CTC LEAF: 46,586 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with less demand at easier rates.

BROKENS: Well made good liquoring BOPs met with a fair demand but eased by Tk.5/- and more. Their GBOPs met with quite a fair demand but here again eased by upto Tk.5/-. Mediums were easier and often shed by Tk.5/- and more with fair withdrawals. Plain and BLF teas were a very selective market and were subject to heavy withdrawals.

FANNINGS: Well made good liquoring Fannings were quite a good market but were easier by upto Tk. 5/- over last. Mediums were a fair market and eased by Tk.5/- and more. Plain and BLF teas were a very selective market with heavy withdrawals.

CTC DUST: 10,719 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with a good demand at Tk.2/- to Tk.3/- below last levels. Well made good liquoring Dusts were a fairly good market and were mostly firm to slightly dearer. Medium varieties met with a fair demand and sold below last levels. Plain and BLF types were very selective with quite a lot of withdrawals. Blenders were strong and Loose tea buyers were very selective.

COMMENTS: The market this week witnessed a much less demand with prices declining for all varieties with lot more withdrawals. Better liquoring types sold more readily although at a lower price but Plainer varieties were difficult of sale. Blenders were less active whilst Loose tea buyers were very selective.

Good liquoring CDs had a better demand.

MOMBASA TEA AUCTION MARKET REPORT

Sale No.40 of the 5th to 06th October, 2020.

There was good general demand for the 131,300 packages (8.68m/kgs)on offer and 16.10% were unsold.

Best **BP1's** available saw improved interest at firm to USC36 above previous week's levels closely following quality. Conversely, Brighter sorts were a week feature easing by USC20-USC50 while Medium types were irregular ranging between USC6-USC16 dearer to easier by USC6-USC28. Plainer descriptions firm to USC9 easier where sold.

The Best **PF1s** in the market were better absorbed at USC2-USC8 dearer while Brighter sorts appreciated by USC5-USC22 with Mediums holding steady to USC10 dearer but some lines remained unsold. Plainer categories were discounted by USC5-USC6 and some teas were unsold.

Best **PDUSTs** on offer eased by USC12-USC19 and a few lines were unsold while Brigher sorts shed USC14-USC26 with some invoices remaining without bids. Medium met an irregular enquiry varying between firm to USC14 above last week's rates to easier by USC2-USC10. Plainer types held firm to USC9 below previous prices and some lines were unsold.

The Best **DUST1s** in the market saw an irregular tendency ranging between steady to USC12 dearer to easier by up to USC10 with some lines remaining unsold following quality but Brighter types were discounted by USC4-USC11. Medium varieties varied between steady to USC7 dearer to easier by USC6-USC22. Plainer descriptions ranged between steady to USC4 above last levels to easier by up to USC7 and some teas were neglected.

In the **Secondary** Catalogues, BP's were firm with PFs steady. Clean well sorted coloury Fannings gained while similar DUSTs held value. Other Fannings were firm with DUSTs easier. BMFs were well absorbed at previous rates.

Pakistan Packers lent more and strong enquiry with increased and strong support from Bazaar and UK while Egyptian Packers showed useful and strong interest. There was more activity from Kazakhstan and other CIS nations but at lower levels while Russia were more active with reduced support from Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries. Sudan were less active. Afghanistan reduced interest with Iran subdued. Local Packers showed less support. Somalia were more active at the lower end of the market.
