COMMENTS

This week's auction (Sale # 49) was conducted on December 15 & 16 (Tue/Wed) and, the quantity 6.3 m/kgs was 1.1 m/kgs higher than the previous sale. The Low Grown Leafy/ Semi Leafy/ Tippy & Small Leaf/ Premium Flowery catalogues totaled 2.78 m/kgs, whilst Main Sale High & Medium category amounted to 0.8 m/kgs. The Ex Estate catalogue had 0.97 m/kgs.

Ex Estate teas met good general demand albeit at easier rates. Selected Western BOP's/BOPF's were lower by Rs. 20/- to 30/- and a further Rs. 10/- as the sale progressed, whilst teas in the "below-best" category eased to a lesser extent. Nuwara Eliya's continued to sell at attractive levels. Uva/Uda Pussellawa BOP's were barely steady whilst their corresponding BOPF's eased Rs. 10/- to 20/-. High Grown CTC PF1's were lower up to Rs. 20/- following quality. Neater Mediums were fully firm to irregularly lower, whilst selected Low Grown PF1's sold at firm rates which was in sharp contrast to their poor leaf counterparts which were difficult of sale. BP1's from all elevations in general, were easier. There was sustained demand from China and Taiwan, whilst Japan and the "Tea Bag" sector operating for Russia were more selective. Europe and North America displayed subdued interest.

Low growns met with fair demand. Leafy OP1's in general were once again of an irregularly lower market with the exception of the best teas which were barely steady. OP/OPA's too mostly followed a similar trend. Poorer teas however ruled firm with plenty of interest at the bottom level. Demand for stylish BOP1's was on the vane as anticipated, with a lot of overseas markets having completed their annual purchases prior to the holiday season. The true to grade Pekoes and Pekoe1 grades ruled firm whilst others were irregular and easier. In the "Tippy" segment, all well-made FBOP's/FBOPF1's were firm to selectively dearer, whilst others were irregular. There was sustained demand from the Middle Eastern buyers whilst Turkey showed a little more interest. The C.I.S. and Russia were less active.

This week's auction comprised of 11,395 lots with a total quantity of 6,351,405 kgs.

LOW GROWNS - LEAFY

BOP1: Select best teas in general firm; balance declined by Rs.20-30/- per kg. Teas at the lower end tended irregular.

OP1 : A few select best invoices were irregular; balance declined substantially and at times were difficult of sale. Stalky invoices tended irregular.

OP : Best teas declined by Rs.30-40/- per kg; balance were irregular. Teas at the lower end were generally dearer

OPA: Select best teas were barely steady; balance declined Rs.20/- per kg. Poorer sorts were firm.

PEK/PEK1: Well made Pekoe1's were maintained; balance were maintained. Best bold Pekoe's appreciated by Rs.20-30/- per kg; balance too were barely steady. Teas at the lower end was barely steady.

FBOP/FBOP1: Select best FBOP's in general firm. Best and cleaner below best irregular following quality. Cleaner teas at the bottom end too were firm to selectively dearer; others sold around last levels. FBOP1's in generally firm, stalky invoices tended irregular.

FBOPF/FBOPF1: Select best FF1's in general firm. Best together with below best sold around last levels. However, Cleaner teas at the lower end were firm; others irregular following quality. Very tippy teas Sold around last levels. Well made teas in the best category maintained. All others were lower.

FBOPFSP/EXSP: Except for few Invoices in the top category which sold well others declined and below best varieties held firm. Teas at the lower end sold at last week levels.

Crop & Weather For the period 07/12/20 to 13/12/2020

Western/Nuwara Eliya Regions: The Nuwara Eliya Region experienced bright weather with occasional showers, whilst the Western Region reported clear weather throughout the week. Evening showers are expected in the Nuwara Eliya Region in the week ahead according to the Department of Meteorology. Uva/Udapussellawa Regions: Both regions reported bright weather, whilst certain sub-districts in the Uva Region experienced overcast evenings during the week. The Department of Meteorology forecasts misty weather conditions during the morning hours in the Uva Region in the week ahead. Low Growns: Bright weather and occasional showers were reported in the Low Grown Region throughout the week. The Department of Meteorology expects rain in the Sabaragamuwa Region in the week ahead.

Crop Intake: The Western and Uda Pussellawa regions reported a slight decrease in the crop intake, whilst the Nuwara Eliya Region reported a slight increase. The Uva Region reported a decrease in the crop intake, whilst the Low Grown Region maintained.

OTHER MARKETS

BANGLADESH AUCTION- SALE NO.29 HELD ON MONDAY 14TH DECEMBER, 2020

CTC LEAF: 46,664 packages of Current Season and 50 packages of Old Season teas on offer met with a fairly strong demand.

BROKENS: Well made good liquoring BOPs were again a good market and were generally firm on last. Their GBOPs met with a stronger demand and were mostly a little dearer over last. Their Mediums continued to sell well and tended dearer. Plain and BLF teas were well supported and were often dearer particularly the BLFs. There were some withdrawals.

FANNINGS: Well made good liquoring Fannings were again a strong market and were fully firm with a few select bright lines tending dearer. Mediums were a fairly good market and mostly sold at around last levels. Plain and BLFs were once again a fairly good market and were well absorbed at around last week's levels with some withdrawals.

CTC DUST: 9,292 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with a strong demand. Well made good liquoring Dusts sold well at around last levels. Mediums were a better market following competition and these sold at firm to slightly dearer rates. Plain and BLFs met with some interest at easier rates with a few withdrawals. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: Demand continued to emanate from all sections of the market. Blenders provided useful support with Loose tea buyers also being quite active.

Dusts sold well.

Our catalogue (Sale 29): Avg: Tk 194.09, Sold 86.3% & (Sale 28) Avg: Tk 191.35, sold 94.2%.
