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COMMENTS

This week's Tea Auction, namely Sale # 24 of 2023 was held on June 20 & 21, 2023 (Tue/Wed), and, had a weight of 6.4 mkgs on offer, which was a slight decrease of 0.5mkgs over the previous week's quantity. The Low Grown Leafy, Semi Leafy, Tippy/Small Leaf & Premium Flowery catalogues totaled 2.5 mkgs, while the Main Sale High & Medium segment had 0.83 mkgs. The Ex Estate category had approx 1mkgs.

In the Ex Estate catalogues sold today, less demand with many withdrawals was witnessed with majority of the buyers being reluctant to place their bids due to the volatility of the Sri Lankan Rupee against the US Dollar.

Best and Below Best Westerns declined Rs.100/- and more whilst teas at the lower end of the market too lost by a similar margin and at times were neglected. The majority of the Nuwara Eliya's remained unsold due to lack of suitable bids. Uva/Uda Pussellawa's too lost Rs.100/- and more with many teas remaining unsaleable due to inadequate offers. CTC Teas from High & Medium elevations - the better teas were firm to marginally easier whilst the balance tended irregularly lower following quality. Low Grown varieties however sold around last week levels. The majority of the buyers were very selective in their purchases this week.

Good general demand continued to prevail this week too in the Low Grown catalogues. BOP1/OP1's continued to maintain last levels and at times were selectively dearer. The majority of the PEKOE/PEKOE1's continued to maintain last levels. Small leaf teas such as FBOP/FBOP1's were once again fully firm this week too. Traditional buyers to the Middle East together with Russia and the CIS were active.

This week's auction comprised of 11,354 lots with a total quantity of 6,434,888 kgs.

BANGLADESH AUCTION

SALE NO. 09 OF TUESDAY 19th JUNE, 2023

CTC LEAF: 37,528 packages of Current Season & 110 packages of Old Season teas on offer met with an improved demand

BROKENS: Good liquoring Invoices on offer were well supported for and were mostly firm to dearer following quality. Good and Mediums were also a good market and prices tended dearer with less withdrawals. Plain/BLF types once again met with less demand and withdrawals were quite heavy.

FANNINGS: Good liquoring sorts met with a good demand and were generally dearer following quality. Good/Mediums saw a fairly good demand at around last levels. Plain/BLF types once again met with less demand and withdrawals were quite heavy

CTC DUST: 9,841 packages of Current Season & 10 packages of Old Season teas on offer met with good demand. Clean, well made Dusts sold well at slightly dearer rates. Good and Medium Dusts were barely steady. Plain/BLF Dusts were an easier market and saw fair withdrawals. Blenders lent strong support with fairly good support from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: Quality showed some improvement this week. This resulted in stronger demand at generally dearer levels. Blenders operated strongly with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers. Withdrawals were less this week.. Dusts met with an improved demand
