

LANKA COMMODITY BROKERS LTD SRI LANKA TEA PRODUCTION-FEBRUARY, 2023





Sri Lanka's tea production of 18.7 Mkgs for 2023, shows a gain of almost 0.5 Mkgs to the figure achieved in February 2022. However, during the January/February period of the current year, the production of 37.9 Mkgs reflects a drop of 3.1 Mkgs year-on-year. Out of the cumulative tea production recorded for January /February 2023, the High & Medium grown elevations have produced 21% & 15% respectively, whilst the Low Grown elevation harvest accounts for 64%.
