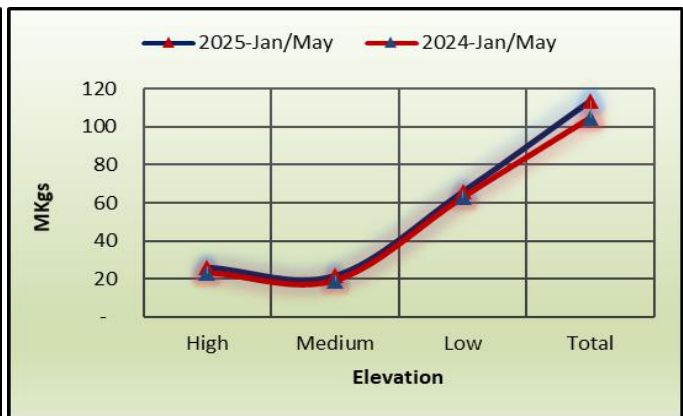
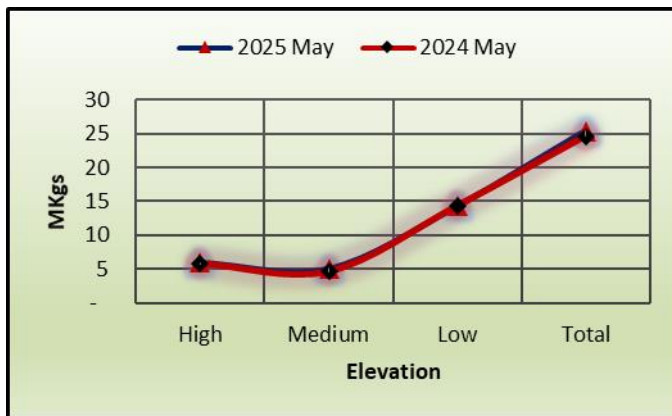


Sri Lanka has produced 25.36 MKGS of tea in May, 2025 which reflects an increase when compared to the corresponding month of May, 2024 by approx. 0.72 MKGS. During the month under review, all elevations have once again recorded gains. During the first 5 months of the current year (January/May, 2025), the total crop of 114.0 MKGS is much higher than the January/May, 2024 production of 104.0 MKGS which shows an increase of approx. 9.1MKGS.
