

LANKA COMMODITY BROKERS LTD TEA MARKET REPORT

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SALE NO.42 OF 22^{ND} & 23^{RD} OCTOBER, 2018 COMMENTS

Plantations have enjoyed ideal weather conditions during the past week for growth, and an all-round improvement in crop intakes have been reported from most districts. The department of Meteorology however, predicts heavy rainfall in the days ahead which may once again slowdown flush in the short term.

This week's auction quantity of 5.6 Mkgs reflected a marginal improvement over the previous week's figure. Low Grown teas comprised 2.3 Mkgs whilst High Grown teas in the Ex-Estate catalogue totaled approximately 1.0 Mkgs. There was a good overall demand for Low Grown teas offered in the Leafy and Tippy catalogues amidst continued strong buying for Iran, Saudi Arabia, Turkey, Russia and the C.I.S countries. Libya and Iraq were active for secondary type teas.

Ex-Estate teas saw good demand at lower levels following more selective buying by a larger multinational buyer. Best Westerns BOP/BOPF were lower up to Rs.20/- per kg and more, whilst below best sorts also followed a similar trend. Buyers from Japan were more selective whilst there was fair interest from Germany for the better quality teas. There was maintained demand from Hong Kong and China for below best teas. Russia was active for a cross section of teas suitable for the "Tea Bag" sector although at lower levels.

This week's auction comprised of 10,145 lots with a total quantity of 5,632,850 Kgs. The catalogue-wise breakdown was as follows:-

Both Western and Nuwara Eliya regions reported similar weather patterns of bright mornings and evening showers throughout the previous week. Prevailing showery conditions over the island are expected to continue in the week ahead according to The Department of Meteorology. Udapussellawa/Uva Regions experienced bright mornings with heavy evening showers throughout the week. However, The Department of Meteorology predicts heavy rainfall above 150 mm in the days ahead. Low Growns Ruhuna and Sabaragamuwa regions report sunny mornings and scattered evening showers throughout the week. Heavy rainfall above 100 mm and temporary localized strong winds can be expected in the week ahead according to The Department of Meteorology.

In the below best category, brighter teas declined Rs.20-30/- per kg whilst the others were irregular. Plainer clean leaf types declined by Rs.30/- per kg whilst the poorer sorts were firm and easier to a lesser extent. Nuwara Eliya's were generally dearer with select invoices gaining substantially following special inquiry. Udapussellawa's were Rs.20/- per kg lower following quality. Uva's were firm, though irregular following quality.

DUST

Demand: Fair Demand.

Market: Best liquoring popular finer grades were tending easier by Rs.2 to 3 and sometimes more. Bolder grades

were selling at steady levels. Plainer sorts were selling at fully firm levels to dearer levels on the bolder

types due to good export enquiry.

Buying Pattern: Major blender AVT and KSCSC were active on the best mediums with good support from regional

packeters. Domestic buyers were fairly active in their purchases. Exporters were active on their

purchase.

COONOOR

CTC LEAF

Demand: Good.

Market: Irregularly lower on the Brokens and barely steady to firm on the BOPF's with an overall drop of Rs. 2/-

to sale no. 41.

Buying Pattern: Good, active participation from the Major Blender and Packeteers alongwith other Internal buyers.

Andra and Karnataka were also buying rather comfortably on the Mediums and Plainers. Exporters

rendered good support.

ORTH LEAF

Demand: Fair.

Market: Generally lower by Rs. 2/-. However select whole leaves were fully firm due to the upcountry demand.

Brokens were tending irregular and mostly lower. Plainers were rather selling at firm levels.

Buying Pattern: Fairly good Internal operation with equally good Export participation was forthcoming.

CTC DUST

Demand: Fair

Market: Market for the Better Mediums was barely steady to firm at times. Best category RD and SRD were

selling at fully firm to dearer levels. Medium PD and Plainers categories were rather outllised with want

of bids.

Buying Pattern: Fair Internal operation with fairly good support from the Major Blenders and other Packeteers.
