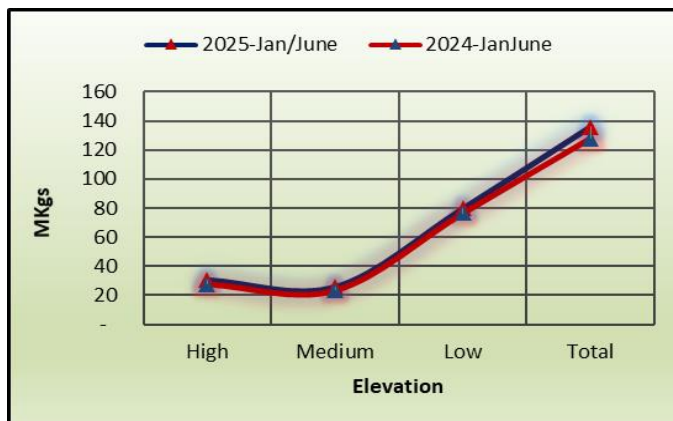
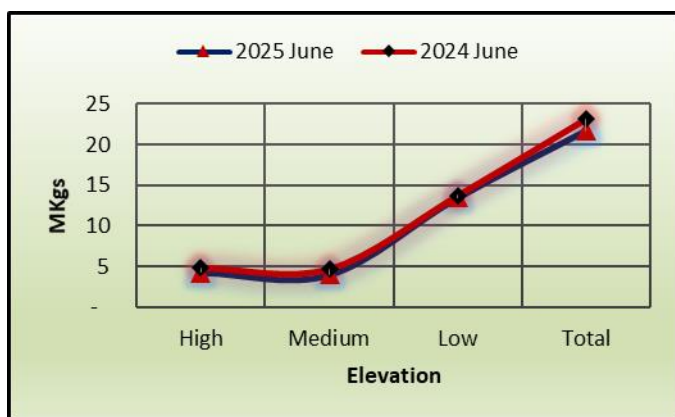


Sri Lanka's Tea production of approx. 21.7 MKGS for the month of June, 2025 reflects a decline (1,466,216) when compared with the corresponding month of last year. During the month under review, all 3 elevational categories have recorded losses over the corresponding month of the previous year, as can be seen from the undernoted statistics. During the first half of this year (Jan/June), the National Tea Production has increased to 135.7 Mkgs from 127.9 Mkgs recorded in the corresponding period last year which shows a growth of approx. 7.7 Mkgs (6.1%). The decline in crop for June, 2025 was mainly due to fluctuating weather patterns experienced during the month
